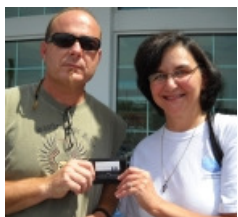

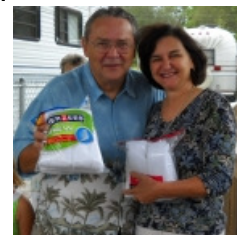
Summer of Socks at Ocean Aire Camp World
